Since their formation in 2005, the Dublin four piece have released four top ten albums and have won the Choice Music Prize on their way to become a household name.

BARRY MURPHY

Barry forms part of the satirical trio Après Match and appears regularly on TV impersonating mainly famous soccer stars and pundits, as well as his memorable major appearances in the hilarious satire, Irish Pictorial Weekly.



Barry Murphy is often remembered for the six years he spent as a member of the cult comedy trio, Mr Trellis, with Kevin Gildea and Ardal O Hanlon. He is the co-founder of the Comedy Cellar - Ireland's longest running comedy venue, and is easily recognised as one of the "ten kings of Irish Comedy over the last 20 years" (Hot Press Magazine).

Fresh from entertaining us throughout the recent European Championships, Barry is back on the road treating the Carrickmacross crowds to his hilarious stand-up show.

THURSDAY COMEDY STAGE - 23:00

KÍLA

Ireland's greatest world music band ever, mixing traditionals with world influences and having lots of fun. Kila perform contemporary Irish music that is Trad meets Irish Rave and back again.



Hailed as one of Ireland's most innovative and exciting bands, the eight members, mostly from Dublin, come from different musical backgrounds and together create a unique sound. With it's roots in traditional Irish, it features a strong percussive like singing and gorgeous melodies driven by a serious rhythmical undercurrent.

Kila have created their own distinctive style of world music, which has won over audiences around the world through their nine recordings and their spectacular live performances.

THE FRANK & WALTERS

Easily one of Ireland's most recognizable bands, The Frank and Walters have long achieved "Legendary" status on the Irish music scene.



Hailing from Cork, the Indie Rock four-piece took the band name in honour of two eccentric Cork characters. Over two decades on from the release of their very first record, the Franks still continue to defy expectations.

With hits such as 'Fashion Crisis Hits New York' & 'After All' (which reached No.11 in the UK Charts) their career has seen them appear on 'Top of the Pops' and sell out venues across the UK, Europe, and the USA every year. Their music today is as relevant as any of the new pretenders on the block and only a handful of bands anywhere in the world can lay claim to such longevity of popularity.

WYVERN LINGO

Wyvern Lingo are a three-piece from County Wicklow, comprising of Karen Cowley vocals, keyboards & bass synth, Caoimhe Barry vocals & drums and Saoirse Duane on vocals & guitar.



Friends and bandmates since school days, Wyvern Lingo share a gift for close harmony, keen songcraft and effervescent live performance which belies their tender years.

Drawing on a diverse range of influences from pop, rock and R'n'B, their voices interweave to create a fresh, forward-looking sound. Their huge radio hits; Used, Subside and Letter to Willow will be instantly recognisable as will the voice of Karen, who dueted on Hozier's haunting 'In A Week' on his multi-platinum debut album.

DECLAN O'ROURKE

Arguably one of the world's finest singer-songwriters, Declan's style moves faultlessly between impressionism, and story telling, and can be at home in almost any form.



A dynamic performer, he is at once as comfortable fronting a 50-piece orchestra, as playing solo with his trademark guitar and bass drum. Songs of O'Rourke's have been covered by a growing list of established artists ranging from Christy Moore, to Eddi Reader, to Josh Groban.

Even The Jam's Paul Weller is an admirer describing O'Rourke's 'Galileo', as "possibly the greatest song written in the last 30 years." With that kind of praise it's hardly a surprise Declan is often regarded as the Luke Kelly of a new generation.

WALLIS BIRD

At the very early age of 6 months, Wallis Bird got her first guitar and thus began a lifelong love with music. An accident with a lawnmower when Wallis was 18 months old left her with 5 fingers severed on her left hand, It was this incident that would eventually create Wallis' unique playing style.



Although based in Germany, Wallis Bird was born in Meath, she's loudly, proudly, vocally Irish – her accent seeps through in many of her lyrics. Her talent is fresh and her influences many: Ireland. Family. Mates. Life. Love. Pubs. Fiona Apple. Ella Fitzgerald and Nina Simone.

Carrickmacross Arts Festival is a rare chance to see Wallis on home soil before she kicks off a gigantic 60 date European tour in Autumn.

COLUM MCDONNELL

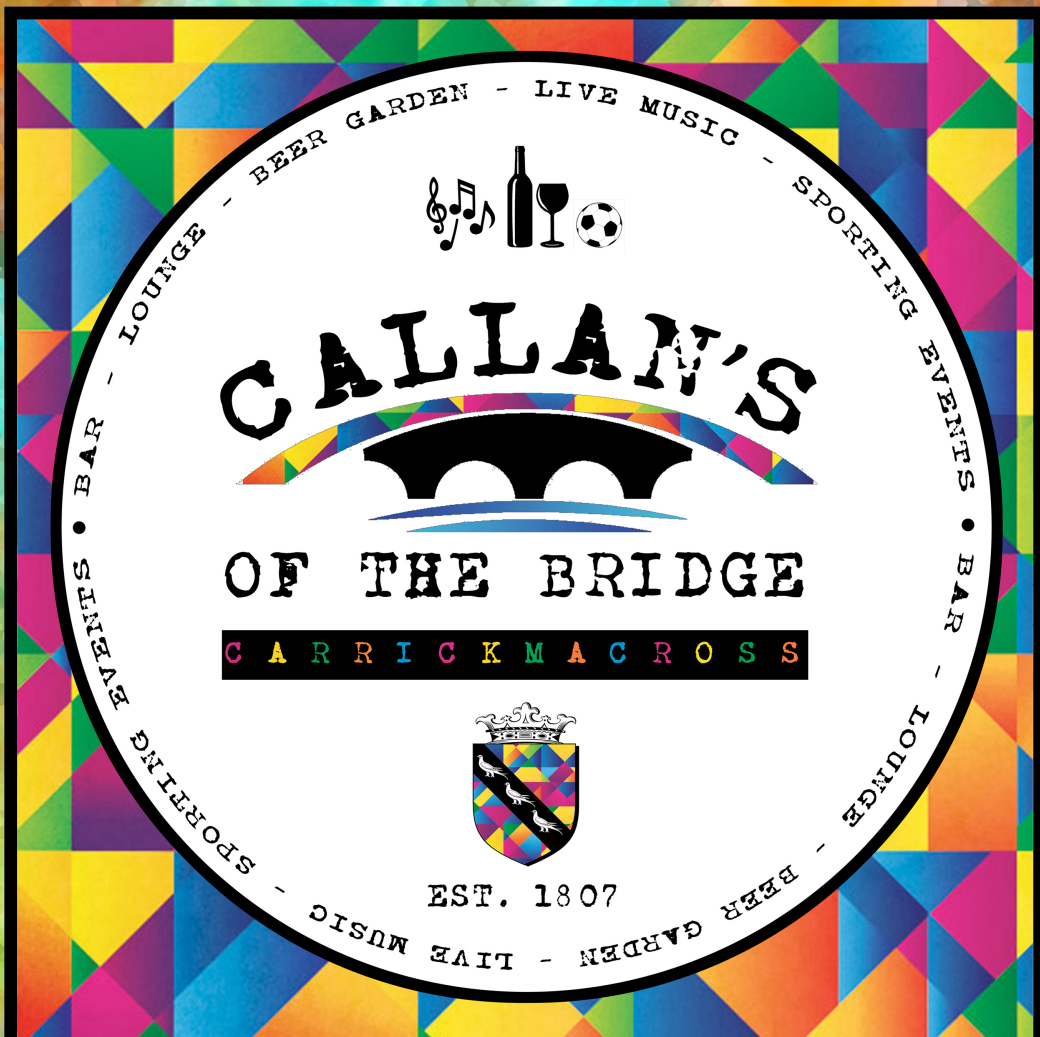
Colum McDonnell is a comedian, actor, writer and broadcaster. This diminutive Dundalk man has stood up and made people laugh worldwide.
